WHAT CHANGES HAS DOT MADE TO THE ALCOHOL TESTING FORM?

- 1. The Paperwork Reduction Act Burden Statement on the reverse sides of Copy 1 and Copy 2 has been updated to comply with current federal law and to include the current address of the Office of Drug & Alcohol Policy & Compliance.
- 2. There is a new DOT form number: DOT F 1380. Note that the OMB Number did not change.
- 3. Additional instructions have been added on the reverse side of Copy 3 relative to the following:
 - a. Printed results can be attached to the back of the form
 - b. Statement to caution the BAT or STT not to obscure the information on the printed result with tamper-evident tape
 - c. Added a specific statement about the 15 minute wait period after a screening test result of .020 or greater and reminding the BAT to check the box indicating the waiting period has been at least 15 minutes
- 4. Please note that DOT also revised the legends in the test result boxes on the right side of the ATF to make them smaller. This did NOT affect Intoximeters' forms because we obtained approval from DOT to print these legends outside the boxes to allow maximum space for EBT devices that print directly on the form.

These changes were initiated in 2008 and finalized in 2010, therefore the part number description printed on your Intoximeters invoice and packing list references "2010 DOT FORM".

To determine if you have the correct form, simply look at the bottom left side and verify that the revision date is 5/2008. If you have not yet ordered new forms please visit our website at <u>www.intox.com/supplies</u>.

IT IS MANDATORY UNDER DOT REGULATIONS TO USE THE NEW FORM AS OF 1/1/2011.

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
